



Urban Water Cycle Model

We can visit your school with our urban water cycle model and host multiple sessions.

Suited to Year 2 – Year 8, this 3D working model displays the ACT and surrounding regions water supply network, the water cycle and the amazing journey through the ACT's urban water and sewerage system right to the taps.

Find out where your drinking water comes from and how it is treated, as well as where the water goes once it is flushed or goes down the drain. Discover how we treat sewage to produce high quality water that can be returned to the Murrumbidgee river.

Session Requirements

- The model can be brought to your school and set up in a level ground floor classroom location
- Multiple class sessions are encouraged with bookings
- The model requires approximately 15 minutes set up and pack up time, with assistance and access to water to fill and run the model
- Sessions will run for 30 – 40 minutes
- Sessions are tailored for each audience and for students according to curriculum outcomes
- Each sessions is capped to approx. 30 participants, for minimum of two classes per site visit.
