products

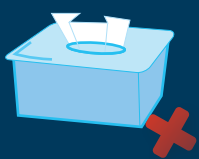


Household washing

or clothing



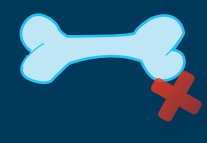
Large quantities of

shells, fish



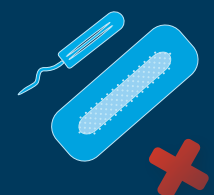
Hair
