

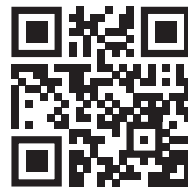

Our bioreactor project

June 2026

Our surface miner has completed its work on site, marking an important milestone for the project! Since February, it has been busy excavating the site of our new bioreactor.

Now that these excavations are complete, we're moving into the next phase: preparing and laying the foundations. Once these foundations are in place, we'll be ready to begin construction.

What's happening on site?

Now that our surface miner has finished its excavations, it will be disassembled and removed from site.

We're now preparing to lay the foundations for our bioreactor.

What's happening next?

We're planning three major concrete pours, which are expected to occur in September, October and November. These pours will create the structure that will form our bioreactor's foundation. The largest of these will lay 950m³ of concrete, which is a little over a third the volume of an Olympic-sized swimming pool.

How might this impact you?

There will be a gradual increase in traffic travelling to and from site.

This traffic will use Drake-Brockman Drive, Pro Hart Avenue, and Stockdill Drive.

Local residents can expect temporary increases in traffic when we conduct our major concrete pours in September, October and November.

We will continue to keep you informed about upcoming work and any significant changes to traffic conditions as the project progresses.

What are our on-site work hours?

You can expect construction activity on site between 6:30am and 5:30pm, Monday to Friday. On Saturdays, work may occur from 6:30am and 4pm. Minor work may occasionally be required outside of these hours.

We will do our best to notify residents in advance of any major disruptions to traffic conditions during the construction period.
